

Why study Elements of Art?

Art cannot be made without the use of basic art elements.

Knowing the different elements also enables us to describe and detail an artist's artwork.


It is a common language used by artists.



We use <u>dots</u> and <u>lines</u> when we draw. Here are some <u>drawing techniques</u> that use each EoA.

Stippling

A drawing technique that only uses **DOTS!**



Hatching

Cross-Hatching


TWO drawing techniques that only use **LINES!**

We take a pencil and make a rubbing over an uneven surface to transfer its texture onto paper.


(This is also known as frottage.)


