# Hatching

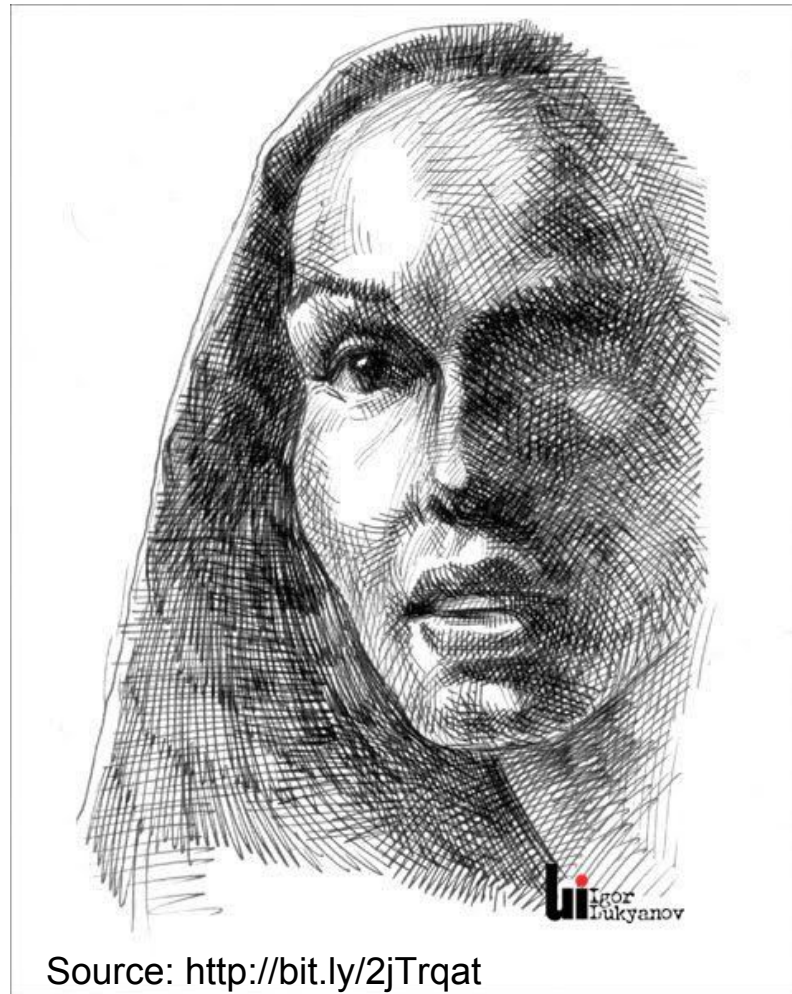
Hatching is the use of fine, parallel lines drawn closely together. It creates the illusion of **shade** or **texture** in a drawing.



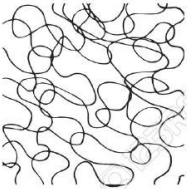
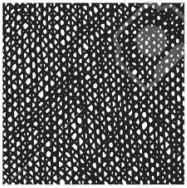
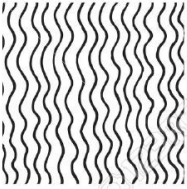
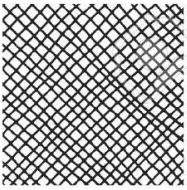
# Cross Hatching

Crosshatching is the drawing of **two layers of hatching at right-angles** to create a **mesh-like pattern**.

Crosshatching is often used to create **tonal effects**.



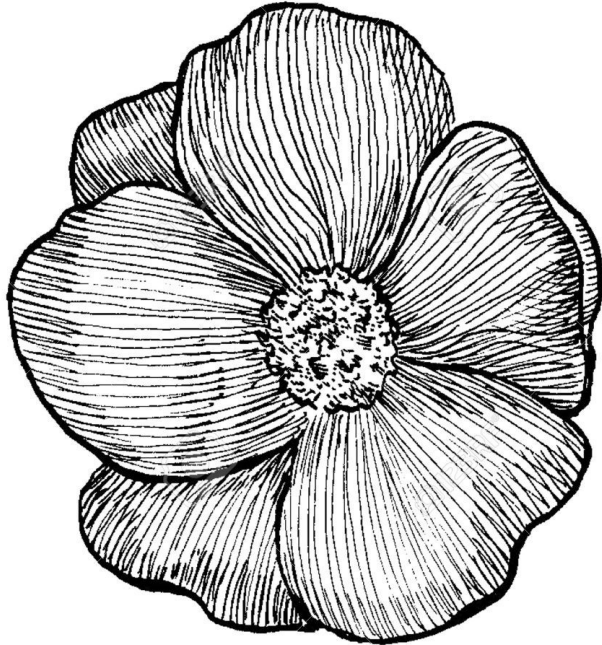

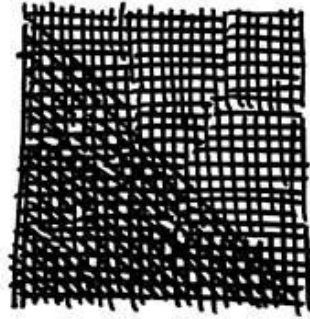
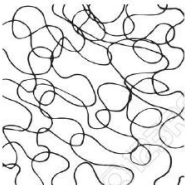
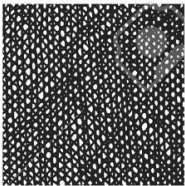
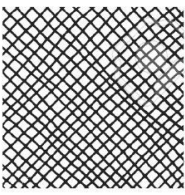
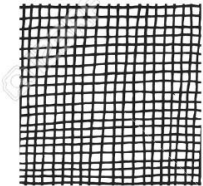
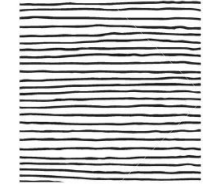
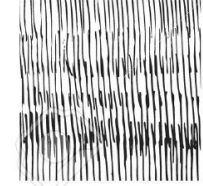
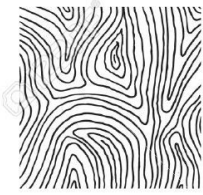
# Hatching vs. Cross Hatching



Hatching has lines that goes in one direction whereas cross hatching is done through overlapping of lines.



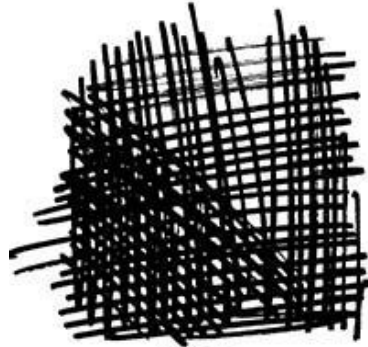

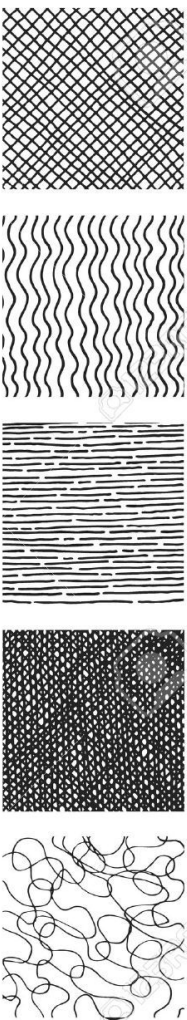
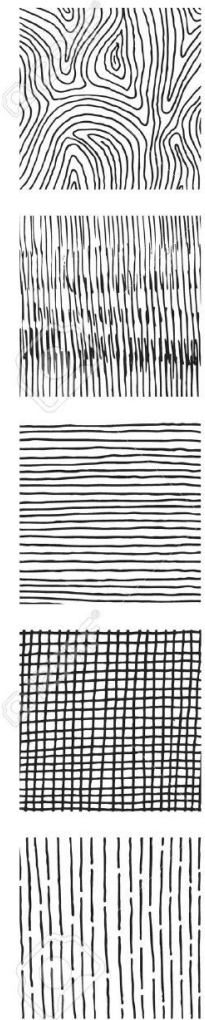
# Why study drawing techniques?
